School feeding program at La Croix Maingot Primary School

The Rotary Club of Saint Lucia has for many years supported a program that ensures all children receive a meal when attending school at the La Croix Maingot, a rural Secondary School.

School Principal Christina Norley updated the club on the program



Norley took up the Principal position in January 2013. She recalled facing challenges with many of the children not eating before or while attending school.

In the school record she noted that the Rotary Club of Saint Lucia had a relationship with the school that had somehow lapsed. She decided to write to then President Konrad. While according to her words, she never received a formal written answer from Rotary, help arrived shortly thereafter in the person of Rot. Cyril presenting a cheque to purchase food items. With that the school feeding program was reactivated and continues to this day.

Principal Norley expressed her appreciation to Rot. Cyril and all members of the Rotary Club for their unwavering support of the school and children.

Pres. Tim presented her with another cheque in excess of \$ 5,000.

Most Rotarians would also recall the 2012 Christmas Party held at the school, including Rot. David's fireworks display.
